## PHOTOGRAPH COLLECTION

The ITC Library contains a unique photograph collection of over 3.5 million items, including original materials as well as copies of prints and negatives.

This collection contains valuable historical and cultural documentation of the state's settlements and changing landscape, agriculture, cityscapes, events, organizations, ranching, daily life, sports, and both Texan and visiting celebrities, ranging in date from mid-19th century to late 20th century.

The ITC Library is recognized for having the most extensive collection of photographic images documenting the local history of San Antonio and surrounding areas.



## PHOTOGRAPH SALES

The ITC Library sells copies of images in its photograph collections as digital images, standard prints, enlargements mounted on gatorfoam, and slides.



**Printed Photographs:** Digital prints are made on Epson's Premium glossy, Epson's Premium luster, or Epson's Premium matte archival paper with Epson's archival inks.

**Dry-mounted Prints:** Prints are dry-mounted on super-rigid gatorfoam.

**Slides:** Black & white or color 35mm slides.

Please allow a minimum of 10-15 working days for the processing of an order. Rush orders will be accepted on a case-by-case basis. All orders not picked up 6 months from order-completion date will be discarded.

## PUBLICATION/USE FEES

Permission may be granted for one-time, non-exclusive use of photographs in publications, exhibitions, or for other purposes approved by the Library. Any subsequent use of the same photograph requires separate permission.

Use the "Request for Permission to Publish" or the "Reproduction of Materials" forms to place a request.

Some images have restrictions on use. To obtain copies of such images, requester must have written approval from the donor for that use.

Proper credit to the Institute of Texan Cultures must be given with use of images from the Library's photograph collection unless otherwise specified by the Library.

Any person or publication not meeting this requirement may be denied further use of the collections.

The fees in the PUBLICATION/USE FEES schedule are for one-time worldwide use in all languages.
