

ITC Internships

Interns will work a total of 150 hours per semester, and the majority of positions are unpaid. Paid internship positions are highly competitive and only a limited number are offered each semester. Competitive candidates will show excellent writing and analytical skills, the ability to work independently and in teams, and the ability to handle multiple priorities and meet deadlines. Paid internships earn \$10 an hour for a maximum of 150 hours.

We are looking for future teachers interested in hands-on experience developing curricula and digital content. As part of the re-visioning of ITC, the Education and Outreach Department is reimagining its educational resources in a new series, tentatively titled “Teyshans: People, Places and Ideas from Texas.” This project will involve updating and revising current content, creating multimedia resources, and developing new curricula and programs. Much of our materials are intended for 4th to 8th graders, but we can adapt content for other audiences. You will also have an opportunity to practice your curricula with K-12 field trip groups during the Fall.

Minimum Requirements

- An interest in learning how informal education can supplement classroom practice
- Strong writing and research skills
- Ability to meet deadlines and manage multiple tasks

Preferred Qualifications

- Familiarity with TEKS and other Texas state education standards
- Some instruction or presentation experience

Work modalities are flexible, but students should be able to work on-site at the ITC at least one day per week.
